**Title:** REPORT - CONTRACT EXTENSION - TENTH AMENDMENT TO F000799 GOLDEN GATE LANDSCAPE MANAGEMENT SYSTEMS INC, SANTA ROSA, CALIFORNIA

**BACKGROUND:** Landscape services, initially provided by Recreation & Parks, were outsourced as part of the 2009-10 budget savings strategies. Landscape services are required throughout various City of Santa Rosa locations, and the current Agreement is due to expire August 30, 2018. Approval of the tenth amendment will provide ongoing services while allowing City staff the additional time needed to measure deliverables being provided to address non-glyphosate, organic weed control methods within a new solicitation, ensure the Russian River-Friendly Landscape Guidelines compliance where applicable, provide for cost impact analysis, and solicit industry through a well-developed Request for Proposals(RFP) process. The Contractor will continue to only use Organic Material Review Institute (OMRI) approved products for weed control. No Glyphosate will be utilized.

**RECOMMENDATION:** It is recommended by the Finance and Recreation & Parks Departments that the Council, by resolution, approve the Tenth Amendment to General Services Agreement (GSA) F000799 for a one-year contract extension for landscape services with Golden Gate Landscape Management, Inc., Santa Rosa, California, with no increase to service rates, in the total amount not to exceed \$549,789.84 bringing the total Agreement amount not to exceed \$2,579,337.18.
