Title: REPORT - SONOMA COUNTY ROAD TAX MEASURE (This item is being continued to October 14,

2014)

BACKGROUND: The County of Sonoma voted on August 12, 2014 to place a one-quarter of one percent general sales tax measure on the March 3, 2015 ballot along with an Advisory Measure specifying the manner in which the sales tax is proposed to be spent.

Santa Rosa, as directed by the City Council at a staff briefing, advised the County that the City wished to allocate ten percent (10%) of the City's share of the revenues to Transit.

As a result of polling results, the County elected to place the measure on the ballot as a general sales tax measure which only requires a majority vote with a companion advisory measure instead of a special sales tax which would require a two thirds vote.

It is anticipated that the Board of Supervisors will have additional discussions prior to the deadline for submitted a final ballot measure which is on December 5, 2014.

RECOMMENDATION: It is recommended by the City Attorney and the Director of Transportation and Public Works that the Council discuss the proposed Sonoma County General Tax for Roads and provide staff with direction, if any.
