Title:	RESOLUTION - APPROVAL OF THE AGREEMENT FOR FUNDING SPRING LAKE PARK ENVIRONMENTAL DISCOVERY CENTER OF SONOMA COUNTY BETWEEN THE CITY OF SANTA ROSA AND SONOMA COUNTY REGIONAL PARKS OF SONOMA TO SUPPORT STORM WATER EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS CONTAINED WITHIN THE CITY'S NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM STORM WATER PERMIT RECOMMENDATION: It is recommended by the Water Department that the City Council, by resolution, approve the Agreement for Funding the Spring Lake Park Environmental Discovery Center (EDC) of Sonoma County between the City of Santa Rosa and the County of Sonoma to support storm water education requirements within the City's National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) Storm Water Permit. The City shall provide to Regional Parks an annual payment in the amount of \$12,000 per fiscal year, for five successive fiscal years, beginning in 2017/2018. Funds are to be used for the continued development and operation of the Environmental Discovery Center of Sonoma County. The total amount authorized under this agreement shall not exceed \$60,000.
