	<p>The City of Santa Rosa, Zero Waste Sonoma (ZWS), and Renewable Sonoma have an interest in understanding if the city property near the City's Laguna Treatment Plant (LTP) can provide a future home to an in-county, Regional Organics Processing Facility.
