**Title:** REPORT - COUNCIL DIRECTION TO VOTING DELEGATE FOR LEAGUE OF CALIFORNIA CITIES 2020 ANNUAL CONFERENCE REGARDING COUNCIL POSITION ON THE RESOLUTION COMING BEFORE THE LEAGUE GENERAL ASSEMBLY

**BACKGROUND:** Policy development is a vital and ongoing process within the League of California Cities for determining legislative and program strategies for important issues facing cities throughout California. Policies are submitted for consideration by the General Assembly at the Annual Conference to be voted on by delegates from the cities. Each member city has one Voting Delegate at the General Assembly, which will be held virtually on October 7-8, 2020. There is one issue that has been submitted by resolution to the General Resolutions Committee for recommendation and voting at the General Assembly. At that meeting, the General Assembly will consider a resolution calling for the amendment of Section 230 of the Communications Decency Act of 1996, so as to require social media companies to remove materials which promote criminal activity.

**RECOMMENDATION:** It is recommended by the Communications and Intergovernmental Relations Office that the Council, by motion, (a) consider taking a position on a proposed LOCC resolution calling for the amendment of Section 230 of the Communications Decency Act of 1996 to require social media companies to remove materials which promote criminal activity, and (b) provide associated direction to its Voting Delegate for the upcoming meeting of the League General Assembly.
