Title: REPORT - COMMUNITY IMPROVEMENT GRANT PROGRAM Q3 APPLICATIONS FOR FUNDING

BACKGROUND: On July 1, 2021, the Community Advisory Board (CAB) released the Community Improvement Grant Application for Quarter 3 to the public. The application period closed on September 30, 2021. The CAB received 11 applications for funding, totaling \$27,323. The projects are as follows:
