|                | BACKGROUND: The issuance of tax exempt, private activity bonds must be approved by the jurisdiction the project is located in following a public hearing. MM Aviara, L.P., a California limited partnership ("Borrower") has selected the California Municipal Finance Authority ("CMFA"), a joint-powers authority of which the City is an additional member, to be the issuer of revenue bonds for Aviara Apartments, a 136-unit multifamily affordable rental housing project, located at 1385 West College Avenue (the "Project"), in an aggregate amount not to exceed \$40 million, and has requested that the City Council conduct a public hearing in accordance with the Tax Equity and Fiscal Responsibility Act of 1983 ("TEFRA"). A public hearing is required to provide a reasonable opportunity for interested individuals to express their views, orally or in writing, on the proposed issue of bonds and the location and nature of the proposed project to be financed. All financial obligations of the bond issuance are the responsibility of the Borrower, not the City of Santa Rosa. |  |          |   |             |   |
