SRPD does not make high/low crime area comparisons at this time. Our Reporting Areas (Emergency Service Zones) are not uniform in size, shape, or residential/commercial density, for example, so accurate comparisons are not possible using the ABC methodology.

Also, we do not identify “alcohol related” events (calls for service), incidents (crime reports) or arrests, as this is not always identifiable in the data based on call type or incident/arrest charge and so is open to different interpretations.

For these reasons it was decided by SRPD Command Staff some years ago that we would only provide the data in the format you received today.

I know this isn't really helpful so I would recommend leaning more heavily on the opinion and perspective the responsible Lieutenant provides concerning the proposed location.

I thought through previous emails one of our crime analysis folks was getting those stats for you. But I think there may have been two of these bouncing around so maybe that's where I got confused. If I could get you stats by tomorrow what time would you need them by?

The Coddington area definitely has higher levels of homeless individuals which brings some of its own challenges. I wouldn't necessarily call it a high crime area compared to other parts of the city. I would put it about in the middle to maybe slightly elevated based on my experience and not having the benefit of looking at actual data.

I think there are plenty of areas around there that sell alcohol so adding another doesn't really give me extra concerns.

Lighting and cameras and any other environmental designs that can work towards preventing crime will always help as long as it is maintained.
