



CITY OF SANTA ROSA NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

REPEALING AND REPLACING CHAPTER 11-22 OF THE SANTA ROSA CITY CODE (CAMPING ON PUBLIC STREETS AND PUBLIC PROPERTY) CAMPING ORDINANCE

Notice is hereby given that a public hearing will be conducted by the City Council on Tuesday August 8, 2023, at or after 5:00 p.m. The purpose of the public hearing will be to receive public comment and recommendations prior to the City Council acting on repealing and replacing Chapter 11-22 of the Santa Rosa City Code Camping Ordinance.

The City Council will review a replacement to Chapter 11-22 of the Santa Rosa City Code – Camping Ordinance to: 1) eliminate a blanket ban on camping on public property to align with *Martin v. City of Boise*, a 2019 decision by the United States Court of Appeals for the Ninth Circuit; and 2) establish standards for camping on public or private property that protect the health and safety of the community.
