#### FY 2024/25 Budget and Program Considerations

- Housing/homeless remains City Council goal
- •CDBG-DR winding down, projects either completed or under construction, extensive reporting still required
- Housing Choice Voucher program is balancing allocation and budget
- Compliance monitoring increasing due to new units



#### FY 2024/25 Funding Assumptions

#### Preliminary assumptions, subject to change

- Real Property Transfer Tax- \$2.2M to Homeless and Housing
  - End of ARPA funding to Homeless; allocation between Homeless/Housing not yet determined.
- Impact Fees- \$1.3M
- Loan repayments \$100K +/-
- Compliance Fees- \$186K
- Federal Funds- HUD has not yet released funding for CDBG, HOME and HOPWA
- Housing Choice Vouchers
  - No news yet. Anticipate decrease compared to 2023.



#### FY 2024/25 Expenditure Assumptions

#### Preliminary assumptions, subject to change

- Increases to Rental Assistance and Trust expenditures
  - Citywide salary and benefit increases expected
  - Rental Assistance Payment increases
  - No new positions added
