

Exhibit A – Correction Notice

On July 7, 2025, the Planning Commission, by motion, approved a clerical correction to Resolution No. 11931 to incorporate language allowing requested changes to the hours of operation (condition of approval 14.B) to proceed to the Zoning Administrator for consideration, rather than returning to the Planning Commission. This action corrects a clerical omission, and the corrected resolution is consistent with the original intent of the resolution adopted on December 13, 2018.

Background:

On December 13, 2018, the Planning Commission unanimously adopted Resolution No. 11931 approving a Conditional Use Permit for The Hook Dispensary, a medical and adult use retail cannabis dispensary with delivery in an existing 1,350-square-foot tenant space, located at 817 Russell Avenue, Suite C.

As documented in the December 13, 2018 meeting video (https://santa-rosa.granicus.com/player/clip/1716?view_id=2&redirect=true), the Commission's motion to adopt included an amendment to condition of approval 14(B), to add language allowing future requested changes to the hours of operation to be considered by the Zoning Administrator, rather than returning to the Planning Commission.

Condition of approval 14(B) is corrected as follows:

“Permitted hours of operation for cannabis retail sales and delivery service, as proposed in the application, shall be between 12 p.m. and 7 p.m. daily. Any proposed change to the hours of operation shall be considered by the Zoning Administrator.”
