- Establishes Priorities "Creative Zones"
- Recommends policies and procedures
(selection panels, community engagement guidelines, communication, staffing)

Public Art Policy

- Sets funding structure
- Process for annual work plan and project plans
- Selection criteria
- Public art process (gifts, loans, removal)
- Role of APPC

Public Art in Private Development

- 1% for art ordinance
