



CITY OF SANTA ROSA NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

THE CITY COUNCIL WILL CONSIDER A ZONING CODE TEXT AMENDMENT TO EXEMPT SENIOR CARE FACILITIES FROM THE COMMUNITY CARE FACILITY OVERCONCENTRATION LIMITATION AND SPACING REQUIREMENT, AND TO MODIFY THE DEFINITION OF COMMUNITY CARE FACILITY TO ALLOW PALLIATIVE CARE AND END OF LIFE MEDICAL TREATMENTS - FILE NUMBER PRJ23-016.

Notice is hereby given that a public hearing will be conducted by the City Council on Tuesday February 13, 2024, at or after 5:00 p.m. The purpose of the public hearing will be to receive public comment and recommendations prior to the City Council acting on the requested application to amend Title 20 of the Santa Rosa City Code, Section 20-42.060, Community Care and Health Care Facilities, to exempt senior care facilities from the community care facility overconcentration limitation and spacing requirement, and Section 20-70.020, Definitions of Specialized Terms and Phrases, to modify the definition of Community Care Facility to allow palliative care and end of life medical treatments.
