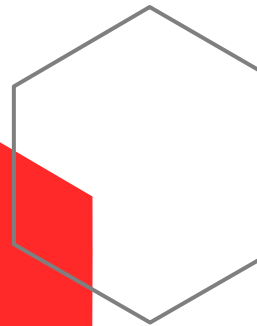
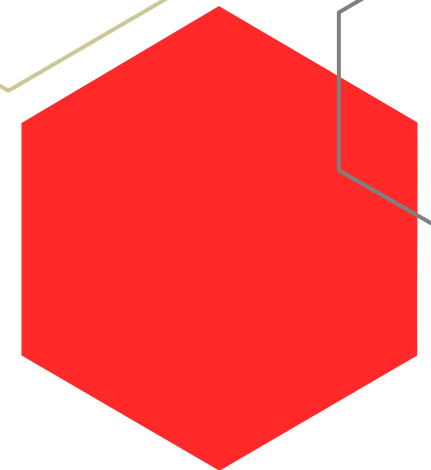
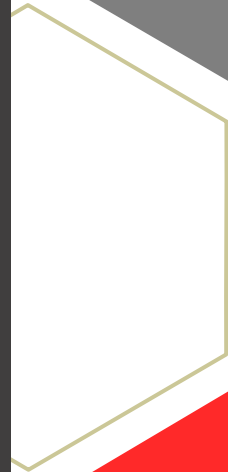
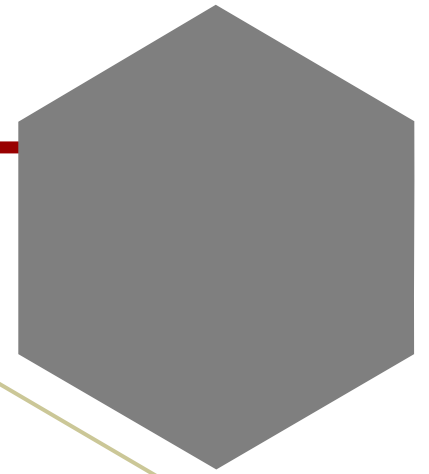
Eligibility

Use of good construction management techniques: Safety, Community Relations, Environmental Protection

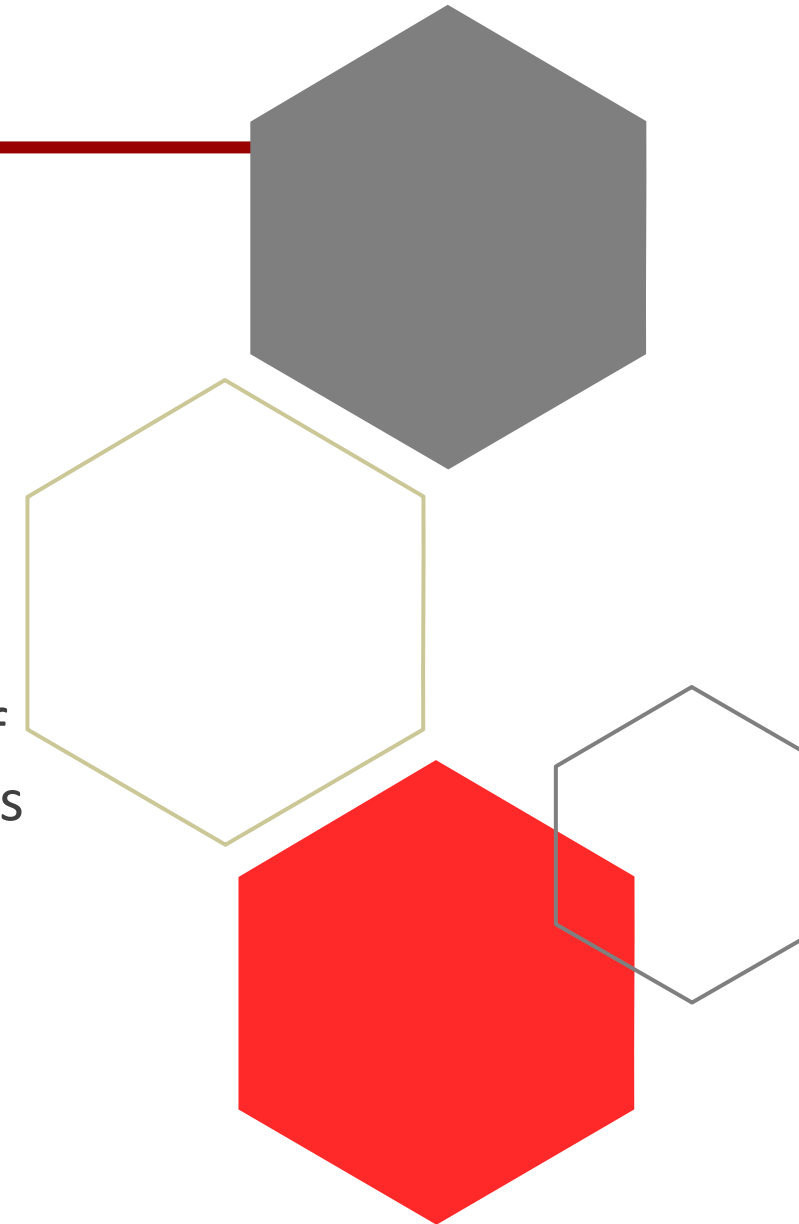
Unusual accomplishments under adverse conditions: Value engineering, innovation, sustainability, resiliency, use of alternative materials, practices or funding
