

CITY OF SANTA ROSA NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

BENNETT VALLEY GOLF COURSE FEES

Notice is hereby given that a public hearing will be conducted by the City Council on Tuesday May 6, 2025, at or after 5:00 p.m. The purpose of the public hearing will be to receive public comment and recommendations prior to the City Council acting on a recommendation by the Recreation and Parks Department that the Council hold a Public Hearing to discuss increasing golf fees for the next two fiscal years, and by resolution approve the proposed revised fees, effective July 1, 2025, for the Bennett Valley Golf Course.

The purpose of this Public Hearing is to provide an update regarding the proposed revised fees for the Bennett Valley Golf Course (BVGC) Enterprise for fiscal years 2025 – 2026 and 2026 - 2027 and for Council approval by resolution of the revised fees, effective July 1, 2025. The Public Hearing provides citywide notification allowing members of the public to provide input as part of the City Council's consideration of the fees.
