

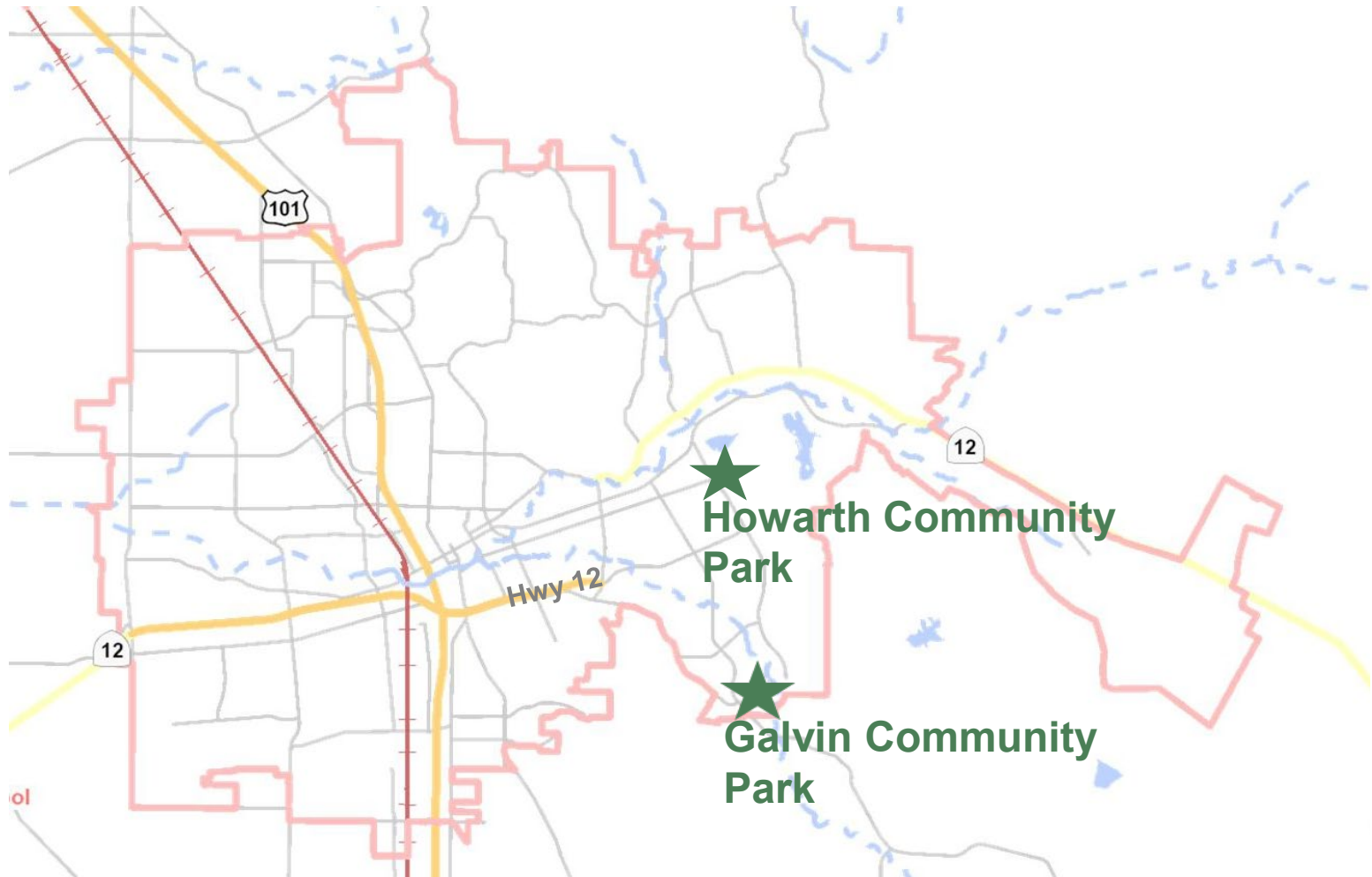

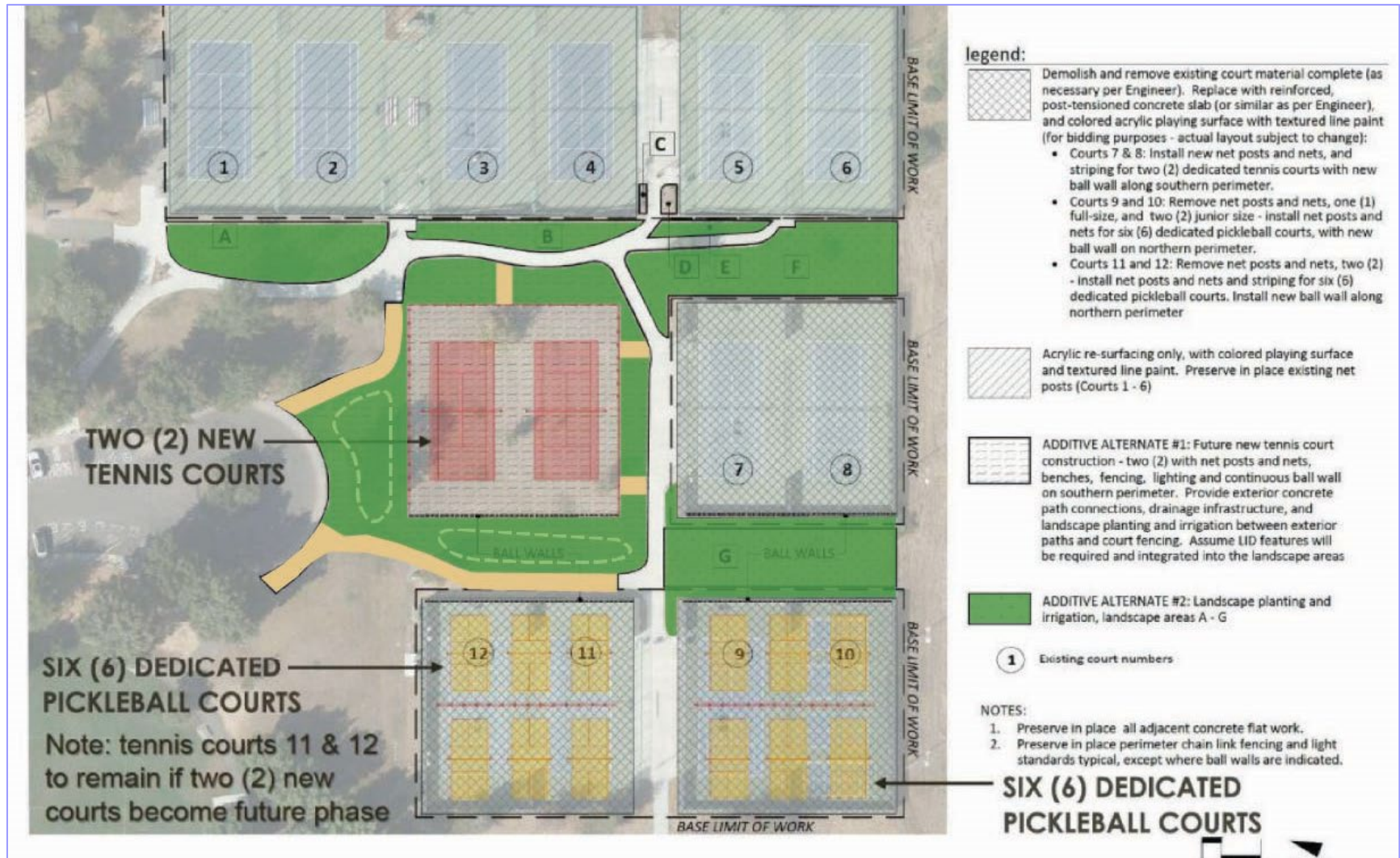
Galvin Park - Project Description

- The renovations will include rebuilding and resurfacing courts and converting a select number to dedicated pickleball courts with new striping, interior fencing, net systems, ball walls and benches.
- The project scope also includes upgrading the lighting system with new fixtures mounted to existing poles, replacing adjacent asphalt pathways with ADA-compliant concrete pathways, providing new picnic tables, benches, and shade structures.

Galvin Park - Project Description

- The majority of the existing perimeter fencing, are anticipated to be protected in place.
- Additive alternate scope items include two new tennis courts with perimeter fencing, lighting fixture upgrades, and ball walls, as well as landscape and irrigation improvements in several court adjacent areas throughout the project site.

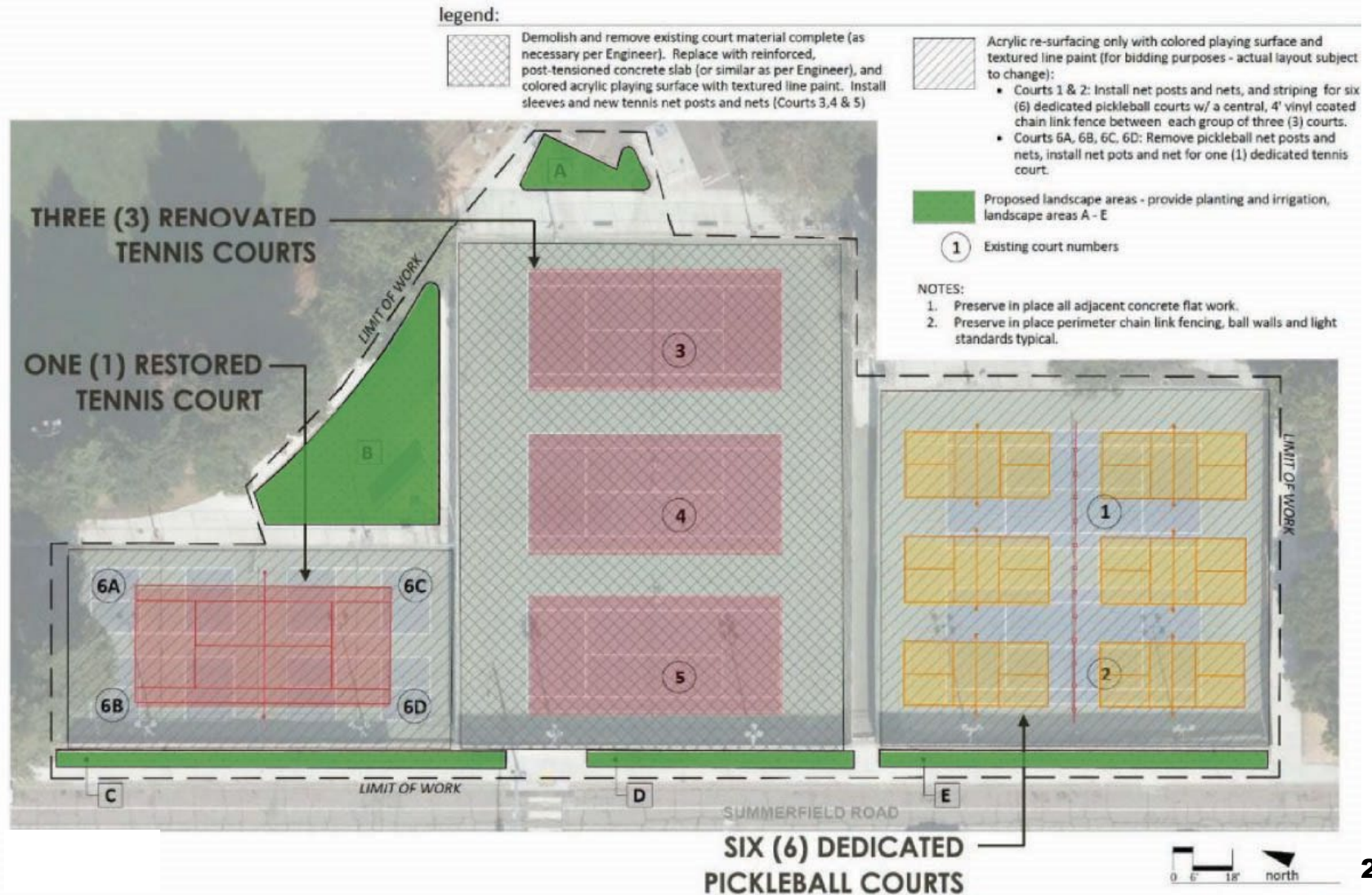
