# Staffing Updates

Position Control List – 174 FTE (approved):

- SAFER employees (12)
- Measure H employees (14)
  - 6 FTE deferred to FY 26/27
- PSAP employees (10.25)

Operations:

- Academy of 7 Firefighter/Paramedics graduated December 12, 2025
- All other promotions and backfill in progress to constant staffing by end of FY 25/26
- In Response - 3 vacant positions (on-hold)

Fire Prevention:

- Added 2 FTE Inspector positions – Measure H (two current Ltd Term Fire Inspectors moved to FTE, creating two Limited Term Fire Inspector Vacancies – one filled)
- 1 vacant – Community Outreach Specialist - FTE

Administration

- Full staffing

# Fire Stations

## Fire Station 5 (Fountaingrove):

- Grand Opening – November 15, 2025
- Operating and working through minor issues

## Fire Station 8 (Roseland):

- Groundbreaking – November 14, 2025
- Completion – June 2027

## Fire Station 9 (Southeast):

- Currently working with Real Estate on location of new Fire Station 9 funded by Measure H.
- SRA/Elsa – focus is on retrofitting a current structure

## Fire Station 11 (Junior College District)

- Opened and funding CIP account for permanent station

# Fleet

Current apparatus on order:

- Type 1 Fire Engines – 5
  - Scheduled for delivery in March 2026
  - 4 GF, 1 PSAP
- Ladder Truck – 1
  - 5-year build, ordered in 2025
  - GF – Fleet Replacement
- Type 1 Fire Engines – 4
  - 4-year build, ordered January 2026
  - GF – Fleet Replacement
