
Changes Implemented to Grow Program








- Shutdowns: construction or staffing
- Communication
- Wet weather increases in traffic
- Billing and waste manifests
- Increased maintenance on pump de-ragging & replacement
- Sampling protects process: staffing

Trucked Waste Support Team

- Administration (billing and communication)
