RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended by the Housing and Community Services Department that the Housing Authority review the proposed FY 2025/26 budget. This item is for information only and no action is requested.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The purpose of this Study Session is to provide an overview of the draft FY 2025/26 budget for the Housing Authority's (Authority) review and commentary.

BACKGROUND

The Authority's annual budget process runs concurrently with the City's process from January through June each year and generally consists of two study sessions and the budget adoption. The Authority held a study session at the January 27, 2025, meeting to provide direction and hear public commentary on the FY 2025/26 budget.

The Authority will review the proposed FY 2025/26 budget at study session today. On June 16, 2025, the Authority will be asked to approve the FY 2025/26 budget before it is presented to the City Council with the entire City budget later that week.

PRIOR HOUSING AUTHORITY REVIEW

On January 27, 2025, the Authority conducted a Study Session to provide commentary and hear from the public on the annual budget process.

ANALYSIS

The Authority reviews the proposed budget each year before being asked to approve it

at the budget hearing in June.
