



CITY OF SANTA ROSA NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

AMENDMENTS TO THE SANTA ROSA CITY CODE TITLE 14 (POTABLE AND RECYCLED WATER)

Notice is hereby given that a public hearing will be conducted by the City Council on Tuesday, August 18, 2026 at or after 5:00 p.m. The purpose of the public hearing will be to receive public comment and recommendations prior to the City Council acting on the requested amendments.

If adopted, City Code Chapter 14-21 Water Waste Regulations would be revised to include a prohibition for irrigating nonfunctional turf with potable water at specific property types and other clarifying changes pursuant to state law following the passage of California State Assembly Bill 1572.

The proposed code amendments are summarized as follows:

- Adding to the definitions (§14-21.020);
- Establishing the prohibition of irrigating nonfunctional turf and compliance deadlines (§14-21.050); and
- Establishing enforcement provisions including associated administrative fines and disconnections (§14-21.060)
