### **RESILIENT CITY MUNICIPAL CODE TEXT AND ZONING MAP AMENDMENTS, TO EXPAND AND IMPLEMENT SANTA ROSA RESILIENCY INITIATIVES**

Notice is hereby given that a public hearing will be conducted by the City Council on Tuesday, November 12, 2024, at or after 5:00 p.m. The purpose of the public hearing will be to receive public comment and recommendations prior to the City Council acting on proposed amendments to the Municipal Code related to resiliency, housing, and economic initiatives.

The City adopted ordinances for resiliency in response to wildfires, the housing crisis, COVID-19, and economic issues. The proposed amendments will be to update resiliency and economic initiatives Citywide from these previous ordinances in preparation for future hazards and economic slowdowns.
