Introduction

- Santa Rosa City Council allocates funds at the beginning of each fiscal year to the Community Improvement Grant Program.
- The Community Advisory Board (CAB) reviews all eligible applications and selects the awardees.
- Grant goals: supports community building, improves neighborhoods, strengthens relationships among residents and foster stronger and more connected community.

- FY 25–26: 21 received | 13 funded
 - 17 applications since Jan 2026
 - 8 applications since May 2026

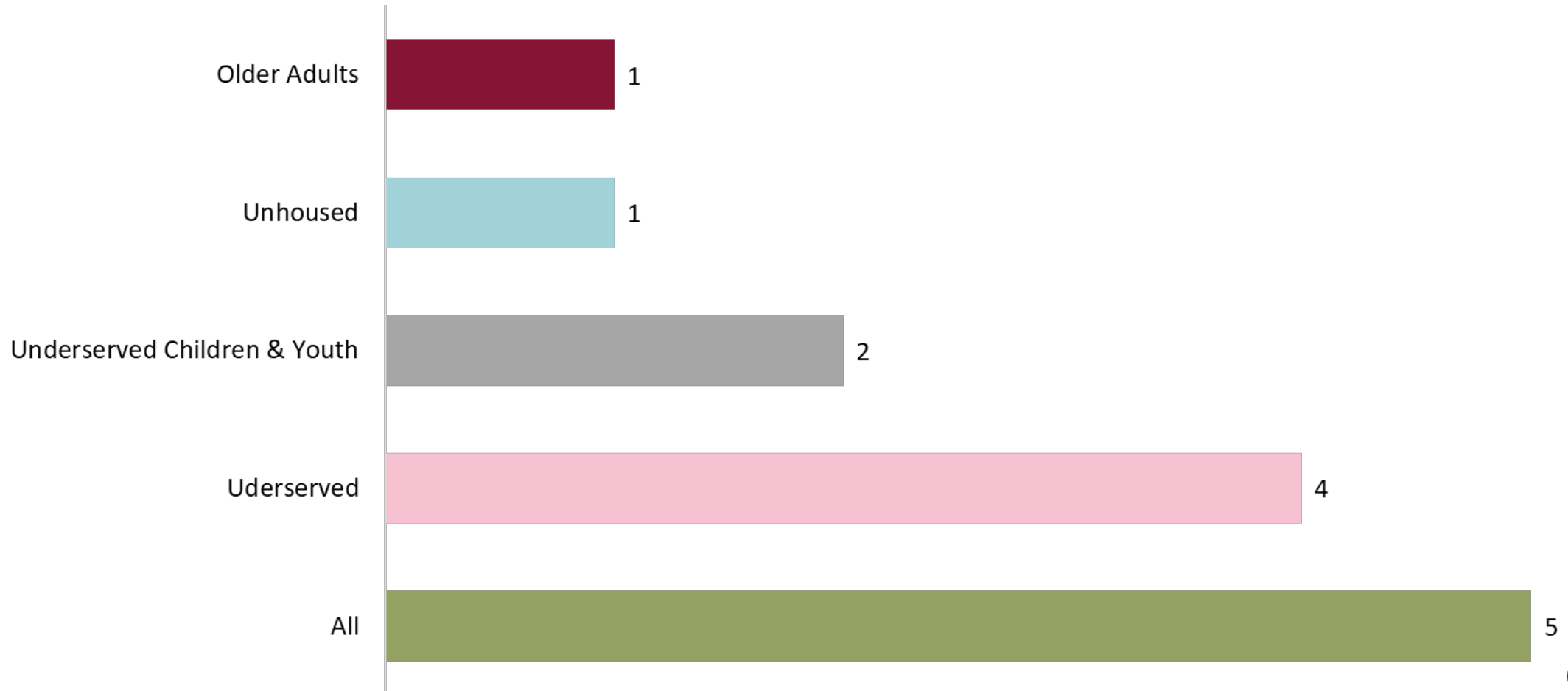
Total Funding

- FY 25–26: \$29,626 awarded

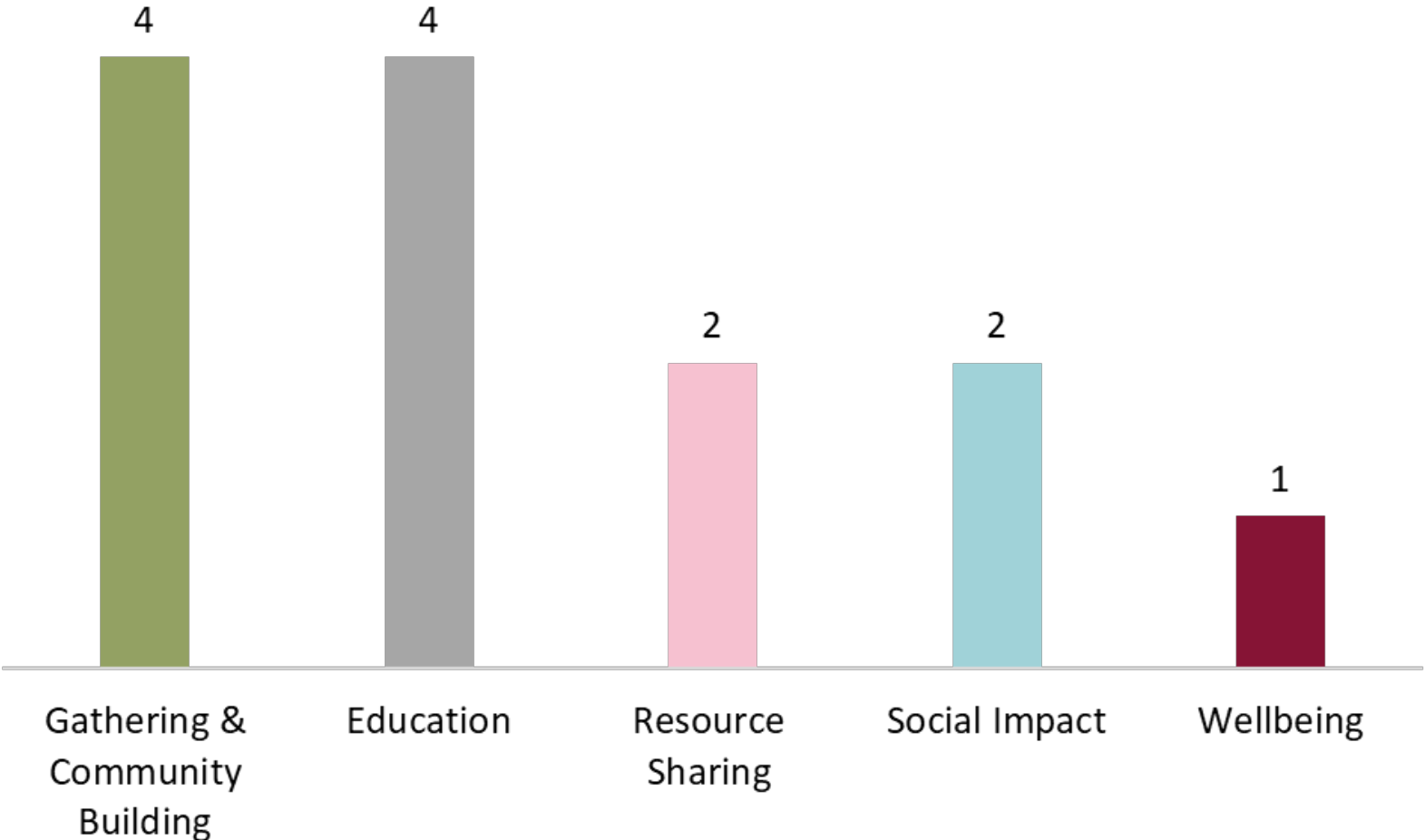
Grant Funding Status & Projections

- Average amount given per grant: \$2,039

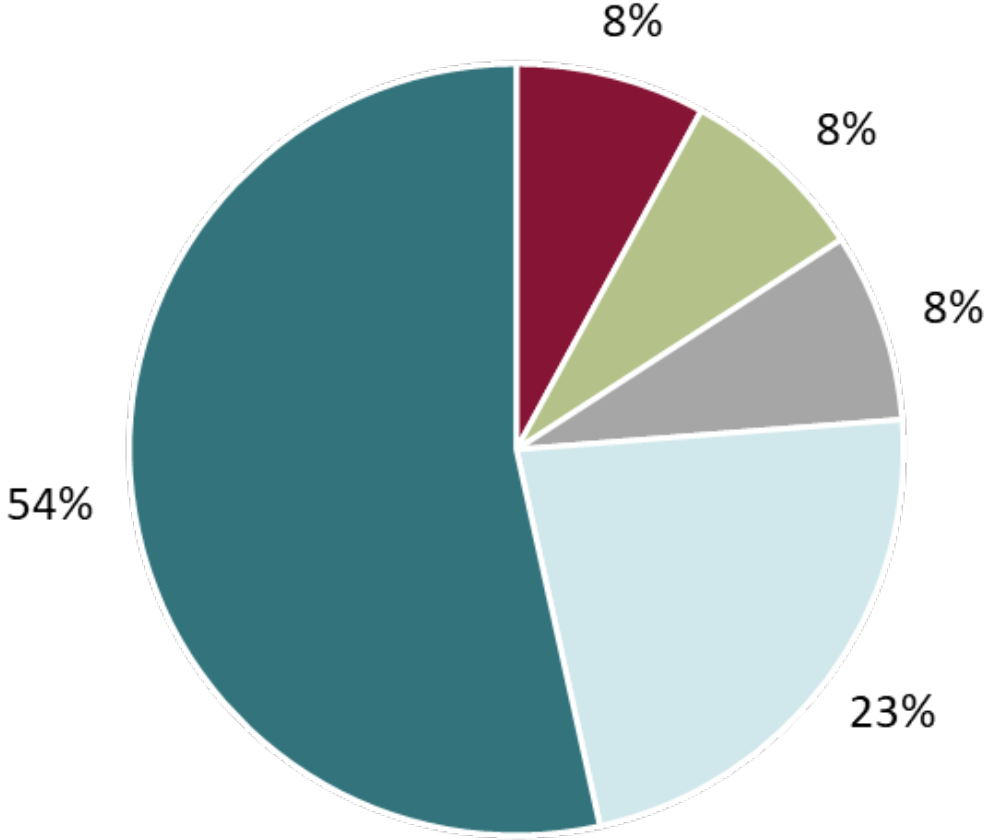
CIG by Community Type



CIG by Project Type

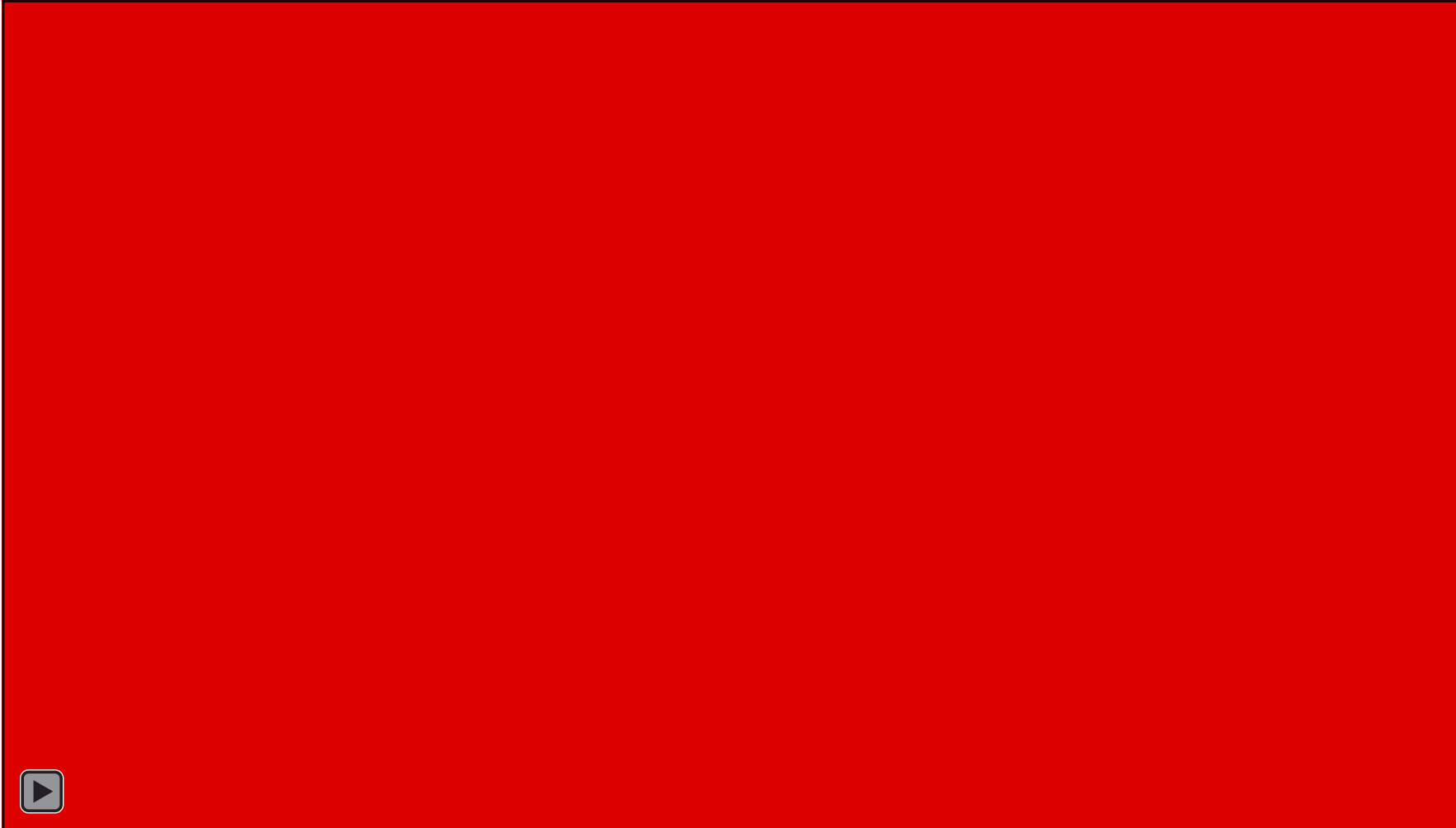


CIG by District
