Dear sir,

I'm writing to express my dismay and absolute disagreement with allowing another food truck permit along Sebastopol Ave. I am a resident of Roseland Mobile Home Park. I used to live by the intersection of Sebastopol Ave and Burbank Ave. and found the noise pollution level unbearable so I was lucky to be able to move further into the park. This park is for seniors only. Many of us have limited housing options. Sebastopol Ave already has an abundance of food trucks at numerous intersections especially down by Dutton Ave and even on the other side of Bux Bear Storage. The noise level is already difficult especially when generally the park requires us to be quiet and respectful of our fellow inhabitants after 10:00 pm.

This permit would allow food trucks and the noise that accompanies them to operate from 6 am to 11 pm, Monday through Thursday and 6 am to 2 am in the morning Friday and Saturday and 6 am to 12 pm on Sundays.

Enough is enough. The noise pollution issue is enough to warrant the cancellation of this permit. Besides the noise, late night open air activities usually increase criminal activities. Our park is not a gated community. My concern is that this would cause a lack of harmonious living that we are trying to maintain now at our mobile home park.

I urge you to deny this permit and suggest that they consider another location further away from a senior only housing area.
