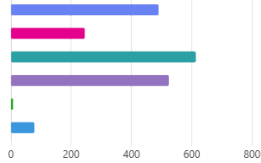

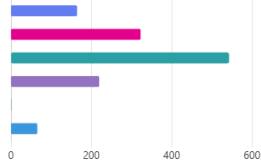
1. How do you use the downtown area and Courthouse Square? (Select all that apply)

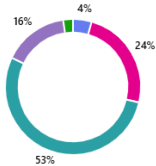
2. How often do you visit streets in the downtown area and Courthouse Square?

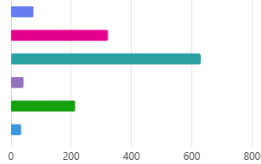
3. How would you describe foot and vehicle traffic on streets near or adjacent to Courthouse Square?

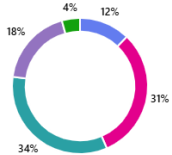

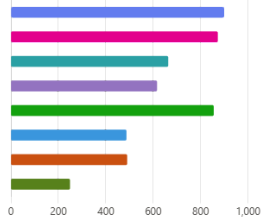

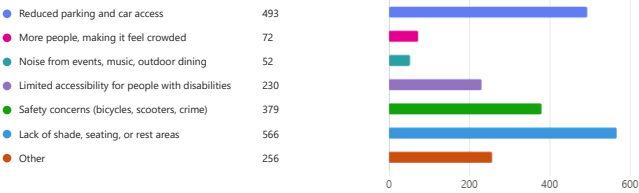

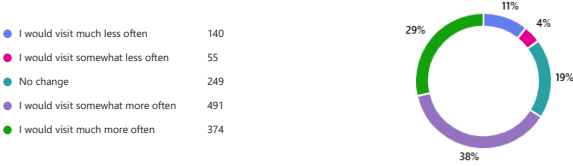

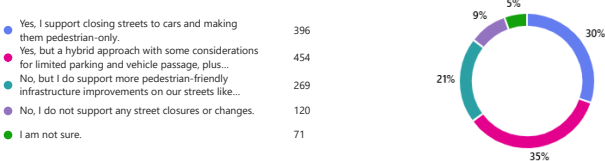

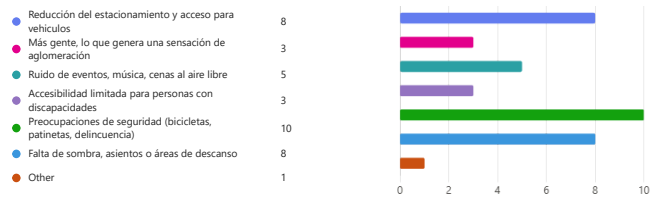
