- * Chair notifies appointing Council Member
- * Council member discusses with Appointee



CP-45: Attendance

- * Not absent without cause if:
 - Illness
 - Unavoidable and Communicated

- * Conduct in Public Meetings
- * Gifts and Favors

* Use of Public Resources

* Positive Workplace Environment



CP-51: General Requirements

- * Work for the City's best interest
- * Prepare in advance
- * Fully participate
- * Maintain highest standards of respect, civility, and honesty



CP-51: General Requirements

- * Be respectful of other's time.
- * Submit questions ahead of meetings.
- * Self-enforcing Code of Conduct
