Weed Abatement Program

- The Santa Rosa Fire Department's Fire Prevention Bureau coordinates an annual Weed Abatement (W.A.) inspection program throughout the City.
- Upon the declaration of "Fire Season" by the California Department of Forestry and Fire Protection (Cal Fire), parcel owners are required to maintain their parcels in compliance with Ordinance #3681

Weed Abatement Program

- After the compliance date, parcels are inspected by Fire Prevention personnel on a regular basis.

Weed Abatement Process

- If a property is inspected and is not in compliance, a notice to comply will be sent to the parcel owner advising them of the Ordinance and a date for the next inspection.
- A second inspection (aka 1st Re-inspection) is conducted and if the parcel is found to still be not in compliance, a Violation Notice will be sent to the parcel owner, listing the violation(s) and a date for the next inspection.

Weed Abatement Process

- If a property remains out of compliance following the Weed Abatement Violation Notice, the Fire Department is authorized to use an approved contractor to abate the property: All costs associated are recoverable by the City.

RECOMMENDATION

- It is recommended that the Council, by resolution, confirm the itemized report of the Fire Department of the cost of weed and rubbish abatement as provided for in Sections 9-08.020, 9-08.080, and 9-08.090 of the Santa Rosa City Code.
