Disclaimer:
To install a metal container 20' long, 7' in width and 7' tall which shall be used as a metal recycling facility. Provided in this Plan with the proposed location of the unit, however, we are open to any, and all, suggestions on the size, color, and location of the above mentioned storage unit.
As a recycling center, we would collect, from the public, certain types of beverage containers made from Aluminum, Glass, and Plastic (PET) such as cans, water, beer, and juice. All containers must be labeled with California Bottle Value (CBV). We do not accept any non-recycled, cardboard, or anything other than Aluminum, Glass, and Plastic (PET) due to the fact that they do not have the CBV labeling.
Once approved, our recycling center will be open Monday thru Saturday from 9:00 am to 5:00 pm, Sunday from 9:00 am to 2:00 pm.
The facility will be attended by a well-trained employee at all hours while open. Our employee will be responsible for helping customers and their CBV return to take our bins, weighing all material using a scale (which will remain within the bin at all times) that is certified and regulated regularly by the Department of Weights and Measurements, filling out all necessary paperwork (such as the Daily Log which maintains how much material we have brought that day), and paying customers, in cash, on site using a credit card but we would have inside the container. Also, in accordance with the best practices, we will keep the area clean of any spills, trash, dirt, or any other nuisance at all times.
We will keep all the material inside the storage unit and would supply it on a regular basis. We strive to exceed your standards and guidelines by:

- Using low profile, low noise non-structural equipment
- Keeping the storage unit and the surrounding area very clean and well-maintained
- Keeping our activities out of the container to increase customer parking
- We would have well trained, kind, employees on the premises at all times of operation.

Some benefits of having a recycling center are:

- We help the State maintain its ranking as a recycling service for the county department and other businesses in the shopping center.
- We help reduce the cost of garbage collection for residential and businesses.
