## Attached are letters for the following state bills:

- Support for Assembly Constitutional Amendment 1 (Aguiar-Curry): Local government financing: affordable housing and public infrastructure: voter approval. Provided for information.
- Opposition to Assembly Bill 698 (Essayli): would prohibit state agencies and local governments from adopting or enforcing a rule, regulation, resolution, or ordinance that directly or indirectly results in prohibiting the use of gas stoves in residential and nonresidential buildings. Provided for information.
- Support for Senate Bill 470 (Alvarado-Gil): Urban Water Community Drought Relief program: Small Community Drought Relief program: high fire hazard and very high fire hazard severity zones. Provided for information.
