## THE CHIEF'S CORNER

As your Chief of Police, I want to speak directly to our Santa Rosa community and reaffirm a message that remains essential to the safety and trust we work hard to build every day. The Santa Rosa Police Department does not participate in federal civil immigration enforcement. Under both SRPD policy and California law, our department is prohibited from cooperating with federal immigration agencies, including Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE), in matters related solely to immigration status. This means we do not detain individuals based on immigration status, we do not ask about immigration status during police contacts, and we do not assist ICE in immigration enforcement operations.

Our mission is to protect and serve all who call Santa Rosa home. Every community member, regardless of immigration status, should feel safe approaching our officers, reporting a crime, or calling for help. You and your family have the unequivocal right to emergency services, and contacting SRPD will not lead to immigration inquiries or actions.

We also know that trust is strengthened through visibility and clarity. That is why we recently created a video showcasing the various SRPD uniforms worn by officers, detectives, and specialized teams, so our community can more easily recognize our police officers. When community members fear calling the police, crimes go unreported, victims suffer in silence, and our neighborhoods become less safe. We remain fully committed to ensuring immigrant families feel protected, respected, and welcomed when interacting with our department. Our officers are here to support you in emergencies, connect you with resources, and help maintain a safe environment for everyone.

Thank you for being part of this community and for continuing to work with us to keep Santa Rosa safe, strong, and united.

Our VIPS (Volunteers in Police Services) can perform home checks while you are away on vacation. The VIPS will perform a visual inspection of your home while you are away and will contact a patrol officer if they note anything suspicious.
