

# Public Hearing Submittal of the Fiscal Year 2023/2024 Action Plan to U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) and Approval of Funding Recommendations

City Council Meeting April 25, 2023

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## Summary

- Purpose: Authorize Plan submittal
  - Required by HUD to receive Community
     Development Block Grant (CDBG), HOME
     Investments Partnership Act (HOME) and
     Housing Opportunities for Persons with AIDS (HOPWA) grants
- Due to HUD by May 15th
- Council action requested:
  - Authorize submittal of Plan
  - Approve funding recommendations

- HUD requires Annual Action Plan to:
  - Define how federal funds will be spent
  - Identify housing and community development needs, priorities, goals, strategies
- Template provided by HUD
  - 2020 2024 Amended Consolidated Plan, submitted every 4 years, used as guide for Action Plan

- Action Plan Goals 1<sup>st</sup> Priority
  - Increase supply of affordable rental housing for low-income households;
  - Provide housing assistance/support for lowincome households with HIV/AIDS;
  - Preserve existing affordable housing stock;
  - Provide housing and services to special needs populations

- Action Plan Goals 2<sup>nd</sup> priority if there is additional funding
  - Increase access to homeownership;
  - Provide funding for public facilities/improvements; and
  - Promote economic development

Note: Program Income = loan repayment generated from prior use of the funds

# Annual Funding – CDBG

- Up to 15% of CDBG for public services
- Council direction: Provide focused, comprehensive homeless services through coordinated entry
- Recommendation: Proposals that met Council direction:
  - \$96,000 Catholic Charities The Family Center
  - \$102,000 Catholic Charities Homeless Services Center
  - \$38,870 The Living Room Center

# Annual Funding – Fair Housing

- Federally-mandated program
  - Criteria: Responsiveness to 2012
     Sonoma County Analysis of
     Impediments to Fair Housing
- Recommendation
  - Fair Housing of Northern California
    - \$45,000 from Real Property Transfer Tax (General Fund)

# Annual Funding – HOPWA

- Federal Grant \$518,964
  - Recommendation
    - Face to Face \$503,395 (97%)
    - City \$15,569 (3% of for administration)

#### Recommendation

It is recommended by the Housing & Community Services Department that the Council, by resolution: (1) authorize submittal of the Fiscal Year 2023/2024 Action Plan to the U.S. Department of Housing & Urban Development (HUD); (2) approve the Fiscal Year 2023/2024 Grant Agreements for public service funds with the Living Room Center, Catholic Charities of the Diocese of Santa Rosa (The Family Center and Homeless Service Center), fair housing funds with Fair Housing Advocates of Northern California, and Housing Opportunities for Persons with AIDS (HOPWA) funds with Face to Face/The Sonoma County AIDS Network in the combined amount of \$790,265 and authorize the Director of Housing and Community Services, or their designee to execute the Grant Agreements and any future amendments thereto for public services, fair housing, and HOPWA; and (3) authorize the City Manager to execute the annual federal funding agreements with HUD and any additional forms or documents required by HUD to implement the Fiscal Year 2023/2024 Action Plan.
