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Past Programs

- Over 50,000 toilets replaced since 1992
 - Rebate program
 - Direct install program
 - Distribution program
- Free fixtures available to all Santa Rosa customers





What is a Direct Install Program?

Purchase and installation of toilet and fixtures* at no cost to Santa Rosa Water customers.

* Fixtures include showerheads, bathroom faucet aerators, kitchen faucet aerators.





Direct Install Program Details

Toilets

- Plumbers remove and recycle 1.6 or more gallons per flush (gpf) toilets
- Replace with 1.1-1.28 gpf (commercial) or 0.8 gpf (residential) toilets

Fixtures

- Remove showerheads, bathroom faucet aerators, kitchen faucet aerators
- Replace with high efficiency models

Open to all customer classes First come, first served





Current Funding



Department of Water Resources Grant: \$1,500,000



Santa Rosa Water match: \$0 + cost of staff time



State disbursed entire amount in August 2023



Final Completion Report due: June 2026





Outreach

- 2,200 letters in English and Spanish sent to mobile home residents and participants in our bill-pay assistance program
- Contacted multi-family properties such as Burbank Housing
- Indirect outreach through radio ads, a Press Democrat article, posters, City email bulletins, and a City website
- Contacted non-profit sites
- Contacted commercial sites with participation in other rebate and audit programs



Customer Approval and Contractor Install Progress

City staff evaluated 600 requests to replace 1,650 residential toilets. Replacement of 1,500 toilets > 1.6 gpf approved.

Five plumbers were qualified through a competitive bidding process and assigned approved customers.
Residential install is almost complete and commercial installs are ongoing.

Post-Install Inspections



City staff conducts random inspections.

During inspections staff:

- flow test the fixtures on site
- confirm that installed toilets met program qualifications and were installed correctly
- confirm that warranty information was communicated
- ask about the quality of the service







1,243 toilets replaced

Hundreds of fixtures replaced

417 sites

\$906,389 in grant funds spent

36,478,000 gallons/year water savings

Announced program and began pre-approval process.

Received \$1.5M check from DWR.


