The approach to evaluating options was robust with scoring matrix that extended beyond just cost of production to include equity, environmental impact, and reliability. Most, if not all, of our concerns were considered and incorporated into the final plan, which I consider a rare and impressive civic feat. I particularly appreciate the approach that we came to with the design team to have "checkpoints" in the plan. Since the plan is designed to address an uncertain future, it seems most appropriate to stop and assess the status and actual needs as implementation occurs.

I feel grateful to be living in a city that is so proactive and conscientious as to be doing this important work. I urge you to adopt this plan and celebrate the good it will do for our future selves and families. I know the first steps upon adoption involve further feasibility studies, and I want to say that I would be honored to continue to participate in further stakeholder groups should the need arise.
