


Current: Planned Development (PD 96-002)

- Uses permitted by right (i.e. health clubs, general retail, restaurants, etc.);
- Promotes uses that are consistent with this General Plan land use designation;





Project History

- August 8, 2022 Application Submitted
- August 23, 2022 Notice of Application Distributed and Notice to Property Owners of Selected Parcels Distributed
- October 4, 2022 Application Deemed Complete
- December 27, 2022 Notice of Public Hearing Distributed
- January 12, 2023 Planning Commission Public Hearing
- March 28, 2023 City Council Public Hearing



Required Findings

- The proposed amendment is consistent with the goals and policies of all elements of the General Plan, and any applicable specific plan; and
- The proposed amendment would not be detrimental to the public interest, health, safety, convenience, or welfare of the City; and
- The site is physically suitable (including absence of physical constraints, access, compatibility with adjoining land uses, and provision of utilities) for the requested zoning designations and anticipated land uses/developments.
