

2022-23 Regional CIP Budget Highlights

- \$9 million budgeted CIP cash funding
- Biosolids Management Strategic Plan Phase 2
 - Over \$200k invested in this effort
- Completed Delta Pond Diffuser CIP Project
 - \$1.2 Million

- UV Disinfection Replacement project continuing construction
 - Over \$26 million spent to date Project still on schedule



Key Take-Aways from 2022-23 Regional Budget

• Budgeting on track for both revenues & expenditures

High strength waste program continuing to generate strong revenues

• Strengthening budgetary position on O&M projects



Looking Ahead

- Finance Department calculating user agency refunds/(shortages) in the coming months
- Annual budget process for FY 2024-25 CIP has begun
- Monitoring UV Disinfection System Replacement project progress and funding
- Monitoring trends in electricity and chemical budgets
 - Will help inform development of FY 2024-25 O&M budget
