Dear Santa Rosa City Council,

My name is Rachel Marcus, I live in Santa Rosa, and I am writing to urge the Santa Rosa City Council to review and adopt a Resolution to affirm Santa Rosa's Support for a Ceasefire and Just Resolution for all in Palestine/ Israel.

As of December 10th, more than 18,000 Palestinians have been killed by the Israeli government, over 7000 of those are children. Innocent people are being killed by Israel in retaliation for an attack on Israel that killed 1400 and took 200 hostage. Every human life is valuable and we deplore the enormous loss of life on both sides.

We are calling on the city of Santa Rosa to uphold its values of peace, dignity and human life. Dear Santa Rosa City Council members,

I am writing to urge that our county adopt a ceasefire resolution in response to the crisis happening in Gaza.

You may be wondering why this would be considered the business of the Santa Rosa City Council. My community has been tirelessly trying to get our House, Senate, and Presidential representatives to hear our voices but as we have seen, they continue to make us all complicit in war crimes using our tax dollars.

We are doing all that we can, peacefully, but these folks are not taking us seriously enough and they are not acting with the urgency that this moment calls for.

I am begging you, to please consider that Israel has gone completely off the rails and has utilized our representatives' support for their "right to defend themselves" unconditionally, as their means to carry out a long hoped-for opportunity to wipe out Palestinians in Gaza.

We recently saw the passage of HR 888 which equates criticism of the state of Israel's right to exist as inherently antisemitic.

I can tell you, as a Jew, Israel does not and has never represented my Judaism.

What it has been a representative of, is a colonizing nation-state that has egregiously exploited the trauma of my ancestors, as well as all Jews', dishonoring their experiences of genocide by using them to justify and perpetuate that very same violence (arguably on a larger scale) against another people. And it has co-opted the narratives of our relatives, taken them hostage- really, and weaponized them to shield themselves from any criticism of its actions.

Regardless if you relate or agree with that or not, you have to admit that strategically speaking, their relentless, heavy-handed military response to what occurred on Oct 7, is both disproportionate and the worst decision they could have made, if they are indeed concerned with the safety of their citizens. Their actions have ramifications for Jews all over the world and the path they are on now will never result in peace or safety for Jews or Palestinians. We have a direct hand in this issue because our tax dollars are profoundly funding this crisis and that money should be kept here to improve the lives of taxpayers.

I have attached a draft resolution and would be more than willing to work with you all on this project.

Proclamation Affirming the City of Santa Rosa's Support for a CEASEFIRE and a Just Resolution for All in Palestine/Israel

WHEREAS many residents of the City of Santa Rosa and the surrounding areas maintain strong personal ties to the victims on both sides; and

WHEREAS, every day we witness relentless bombing by the Israeli military on civilian institutions, such as hospitals, ambulances, churches, mosques, residential buildings, treatment plants, and bakeries, in which nearly 18,000 innocent civilians, nearly half of whom are children, have died and many more have been injured or are buried beneath the rubble; and

WHEREAS, against all international law, the collective punishment of the Palestinian population of Gaza is depriving them of basic human needs, such as clean drinking water, food, electricity, fuel, medical supplies, building materials; and

WHEREAS the forced transfer of the population within the Gaza Strip constitutes ethnic cleansing as has happened to the Palestinians in 1948, 1967, and continues with the ongoing demolitions of homes and destruction of villages and neighborhoods in the West Bank, East Jerusalem, and Gaza; and

WHEREAS Gaza is known as "the world's largest open air prison" due to ongoing unbearable living conditions imposed by the state of Israel, including a full air, land and sea blockade, enclosure of its borders by concrete walls and barbed wire fences, and strict restrictions on movement of its residents; and

WHEREAS The United States gives billions of dollars in military aid to Israel every year from our tax dollars – money that is desperately needed to fund education, healthcare, housing, and much more in our community; and

WHEREAS many of the families of the hostages fear the military onslaught on Gaza is putting their loved ones' lives at risk and are calling for a prisoner exchange as has been offered by Hamas; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City of Santa Rosa joins the United Nations, world leaders, religious leaders, and citizens of the world everywhere in calling for an immediate CEASEFIRE and an end to all armed hostilities by all sides in the Occupied Palestinian Territories, especially in Gaza, and in Israel; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City of Santa Rosa calls for the immediate commencement of negotiations between the two sides for the release of all the hostages taken on October 7th in return for the release of all Palestinian political prisoners; and

FINALLY, BE IT RESOLVED THAT the City of Santa Rosa advocates for the dignity and safety of residents in every community and that peace diplomacy between Palestinians and Israelis is possible with the help of fair-minded people and leaders of the world.
